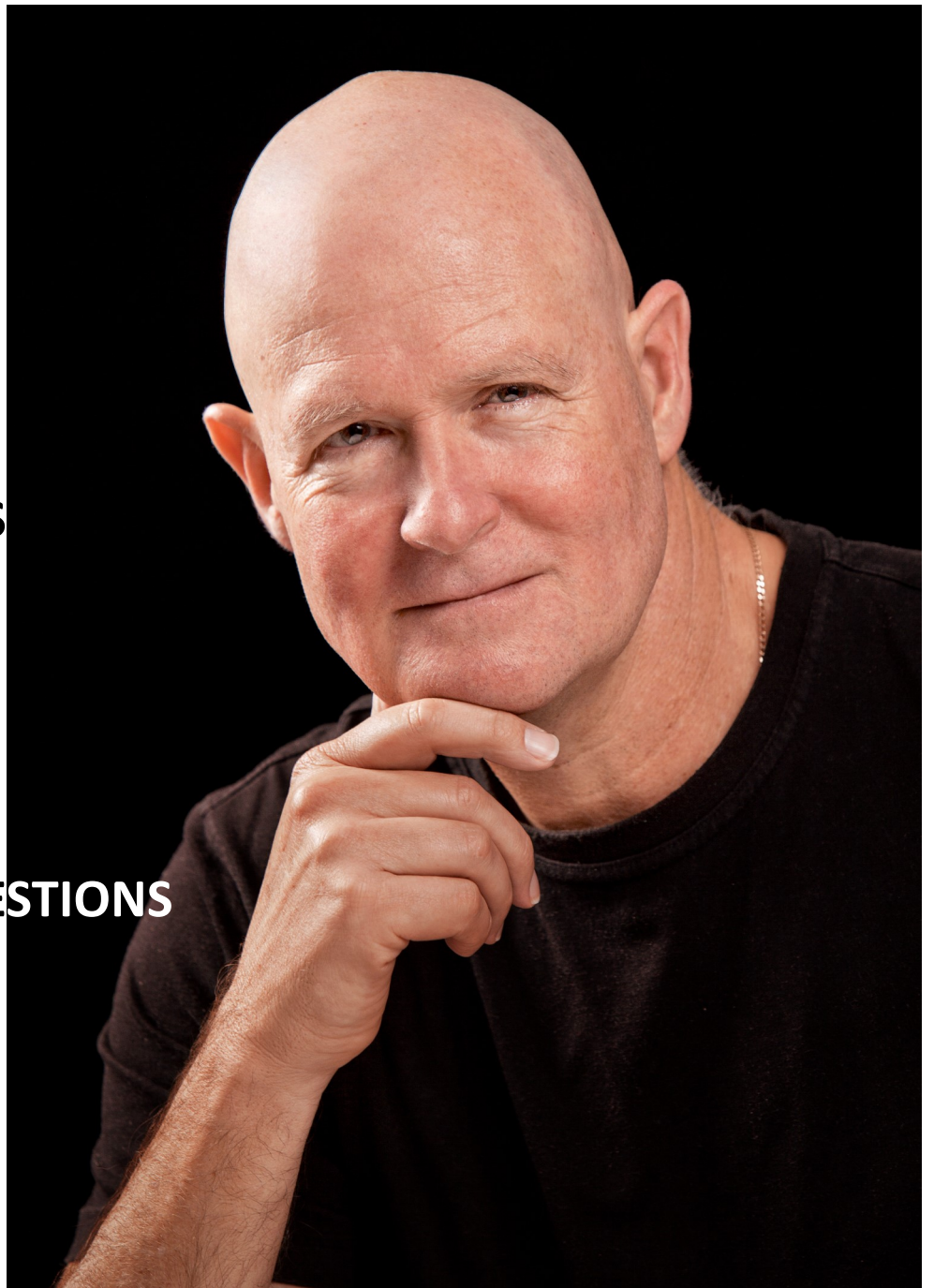

In 2008 he moved to the Gold Coast, Australia where he joined the Gold Coast Writers Association, serving as its president.

*Colour of Greed* went on to receive the Gold award for best fiction in Australia and New Zealand at the Independent Publisher Book Awards 2013.

A proud husband, father and grandfather, his new thriller, *Double Death* is expected out in April 2021.

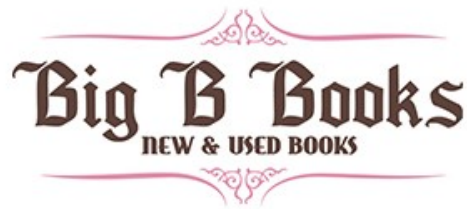

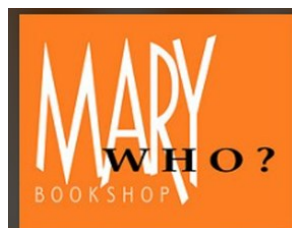

This was a great book, good plot and storyline with a twist at the end. Thoroughly enjoyed it and would defiantly recommend. It's a great read.

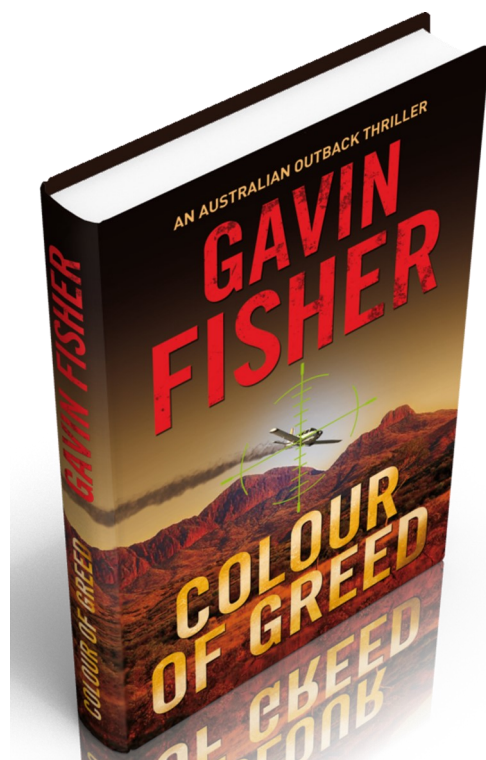

soaked up the darkness, standing perfectly still at the edge of the room.

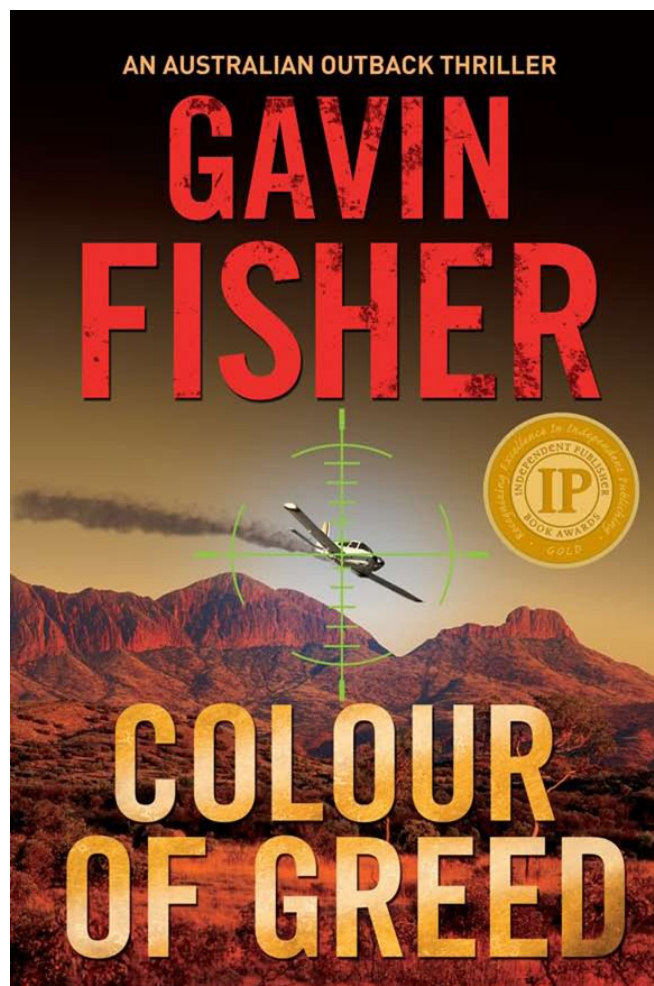
